2. Our Goals

Set in the spice island of Zanzibar, *Our Farm Zanzibar* is a Non-Governmental Organization that was initially established in response to the high demand for training the personnel in the tourism & hospitality industry.

The journey started three years ago, when Yves Montel established The Zanzibar Center of Excellence for Tourism (ZCET) that organizes several managerial workshops in Zanzibar in collaboration with TRY, a leading Dubai based company that offers professional courses in sustainable tourism management. The main goal of the initiative is to empower the local community by producing highly trained local personnel and entrepreneurs that could take mid and top management roles in the industry.

Following the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic many hotels in Zanzibar remain closed. *Our Farm Zanzibar* turned its focus to agriculture to help offer some relieve to the affected families of the employees and to the community at large. The initiative is currently offering employment to former hoteliers, promoting organic and sustainable agricultural practices whilst encouraging the local community to be more self-sufficient and self-reliable. Similarly, the NGO is conducting workshops to impart eco-friendly approaches to agricultural practices for its target groups. This has been done in close collaboration with the association (TAHA). The NGO has been setup in such a way that decision making has been entrusted to members of the local community with the support of the founders.

Currently, the NGO operates 4 different farms, totaling 11 acres and focuses on the advancement of sustainable cultivation of fruits and organic vegetable, pastured poultry and goats. *Our Farm Zanzibar* has become more than a place to call home; it represents community, creativity, and our best effort to connect people with a sustainable farm experience.
